Delaney Group donates over \$6,000 to local communities during Holiday season

Gloversville, NY – When Delaney Excavation was formed over 25 years ago, there was a large focus on family. Since becoming The Delaney Group Inc. in 2007 and adopting the phrase ‘Family First’, Delaney employees have continue to value this tradition. This year, in the wake of hard economic times, several Delaney offices made large contributions to their local communities.

At headquarters in Gloversville, NY, several charities benefited from DGI. The employees brought in 607 lbs of food for the local food pantry and donated 113 toys for the ‘Toys for Tots’ of Fulton and Montgomery Counties. They also raised \$860 for the Nathan Littuar Foundation, \$2,300 for Warm the Children of Fulton County, \$200 for each the Mayfield and Northville schools toward the purchase of children’s clothing, \$550 for Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center, and they sponsored 5 families through the Salvation Army.

At the Route 17 job site in Parksville, NY, employees raised money for several causes. They raised over \$1,100 for the ‘Toys for Tots’ program of Sullivan County. They also helped to pay for medical supplies for a young local child who was terminally ill. Employees in Georgia also raised money and donated over 130 toys for their local ‘Toys for Tots’ programs.
